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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED  
AND NINETY-THREE.

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AN ACT to incorporate the Salmon Falls Manufacturing  
Company.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. The stockholders of the Salmon Falls  
2 Manufacturing Company, a corporation duly existing  
3 under the laws of the state of New Hampshire, their suc-  
4 cessors and assigns are hereby constituted a body corpor-  
5 ate and politic, by the name of the Salmon Falls Manu-  
6 facturing Company, with all the powers, privileges and  
7 immunities, and subject to all the liabilities of like manu-  
8 facturing corporations; and said corporation is hereby  
9 authorized to purchase and hold real estate and water  
10 power, and to purchase or erect such buildings, machinery

11 and other property, as it shall deem necessary to carry  
12 on the business of manufacturing, at Berwick and at  
13 South Berwick, in the county of York, goods composed  
14 in whole or in part of cotton, wool, linen, leather, paper,  
15 wood, or metal, and such other manufactures as may by it be  
16 deemed necessary or conveniently connected therewith.

SECT. 2. Said corporation may connect its land and  
2 buildings in New Hampshire with any part of its land or  
3 other property in this State by means of a bridge across  
4 so much of the Salmon Falls river as is within the limits  
5 of this State, which may not obstruct the flow of said  
6 stream, or injuriously affect any rights of navigation.

SECT. 3. The capital stock of the said Salmon Falls  
2 Manufacturing Company, incorporated in New Hampshire,  
3 shall be and constitute the capital stock of this corporation ;  
4 and the owners and holders of said stock shall be and  
5 constitute the owners and holders of the stock in this  
6 corporation.

SECT. 4. The first meeting of said corporation may be  
2 called by any one of said corporators, by giving notice as  
3 specified in section three, of chapter forty-six of the  
4 Revised Statutes of this State ; and such or any subsequent  
5 meeting may be held under and upon such and the same  
6 notice the said Salmon Falls Manufacturing Company in  
7 New Hampshire is now by law required to give of its  
8 meetings.

SECT. 5. This act shall take effect when approved.
