STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to extend the charter of the Oakland Water
Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

The time within which the Oakland Water Company,
2 chartered by Private and Special Laws of eighteen hun-
3 dred and eighty-nine, chapter 416, is hereby extended
4 within which it may organize and commence actual
5 business to December first, eighteen hundred and ninety-
6 four. And said charter and organization of said Oakland
7 Water Company shall be valid, *provided* said company
8 shall lay at least one mile of water pipe for the purpose
9 of supplying the town of Oakland in Kennebec county,
10 Maine, with water for domestic purposes, in and under

11 the streets of said Oakland, on or before December first,
12 eighteen hundred and ninety-four.
