RESOLVE in favor of the Commissioners of Inland Fisheries and Game of moneys which lapsed into the treasury from the appropriation of eighteen hundred and ninety-two.

. Resolved, That there be appropriated from the State

- 2 treasury to be expended by the Commissioners of Inland
- 3 Fisheries and Game under the direction of the Governor
- 4 and Council the sum of sixteen hundred and seventy-three
- 5 dollars, for the purposes of that department and for none
- 6 other.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

There lapsed into the treasury from the appropriation of 1892 for "Inland Fish and Game," the sum of.... \$ 292 58 And from fines collected and paid into the treas-

This sum was not drawn to pay outstanding bills of 1892, on account of the inability of Mr. Commissioner Stilwell at the close of last year to audit the bills of the department.

The surviving commissioner, Mr. Henry O. Stanley, is in immediate need of that sum to pay the outstanding claims against said department.
