## STATE OF MAINE.

#### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-THREE.

### AN ACT to flow Wilson Pond and Hill's Pond in Franklin County.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. F. J. Goodspeed, his heirs and assigns, are hereby authorized to flow Wilson pond, so called, in the town of Wilton, County of Franklin, by erecting and maintaining a flash-board on the dam at the outlet of said pond, not exceeding twelve inches in height. Said Goodspeed, his heirs and assigns, shall pay the proprietor or proprietors, of the land that may be flowed by raising the altitude of said dam, such damages, unless the parties garee, as shall be ascertained and determined by the county commissioners of Franklin county, in the same

11 manner and under the same conditions and limitations, as12 are by law provided in case of damages by the laying out13 of highways.

Said Goodspeed, his heirs and assigns, are SECT. 2. 2 hereby authorized, to flow Hill's pond, so called, in Per-3 kins plantation, in the said County of Franklin, by build-4 ing a dam at the foot of said pond for the purpose of 5 holding water for the use and benefit of the water-power 6 at said Wilton. Said Goodspeed may take land and 7 materials for building said dam, and if the parties owning said land and materials, and the land that may be flowed 8 9 by erecting said dam, cannot agree upon the damages 10 therefor, then said damages shall be estimated by the 11 county commissioners for the county of Franklin, as pro-12 vided by law in case of taking land for public highways. This act shall take effect when approved. SECT. 3.
