STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT additional and amendatory to Chapter three hundred and eighty-one of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and fifty, to enable the Rockland Water Company to increase its capital stock.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. The Rockland Water Company is hereby
2 authorized to increase its capital stock, as the necessities
3 of the corporation may require, to an amount not exceed-
4 ing three hundred thousand dollars. Such increase shall
5 be made upon a vote of the stockholders of said corpora-
6 tion, and said corporation is hereby authorized and em-
7 powered to issue additional shares of the par value of fifty
8 dollars each, and such shares may be sold from time to

9 time, by the directors, for and on the account of the
10 corporation.

SECT. 2. Said corporation is also hereby authorized and
2 empowered to issue its mortgage bonds to aid in the con-
3 struction, extension, repairs and improvements of its
4 works, upon such rates and time, as be may be deemed
5 expedient, by the corporation, to the amount of one hun-
6 dred thousand dollars, and secure the same by mortgage
7 or mortgages of the franchise and property of the corpora-
8 tion.

SECT. 3. Said corporation is also hereby authorized and
2 empowered, to change and re-locate its main pipes or con-
3 duits, at such points and places, in the city of Rockland
4 and other towns wherein said company is authorized to
5 lay the same, as may be deemed necessary to improve the
6 grade and flow of water from Chishawaukee or Tolman's
7 pond with which the same are now connected, and in and
8 along all streets and ways in said city and towns, where
9 a re-location may least interfere with the corporate rights
10 of said city and towns and those of other corporations.
11 Such changes of location to be subject to all the provisions
12 contained in its charter and amendments thereto, relating
13 to real estate and damages therefor, and to such reasona-
14 ble restrictions as the selectmen of said towns and the
15 mayor and aldermen of said city may impose.

SECT. 4. This act shall take effect when approved.
