STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of Industrial Exhibits.

Resolved, That the sum of one thousand dollars be and

- 2 hereby is appropriated to the Maine State Agricultural
- 3 Society, in addition to the sum heretofore appropriated,
- 4 for the purpose of encouraging the exhibition of the
- 5 industrial products of Maine as well as increasing the
- 6 premiums in stock and agricultural classes and also to
- 7 provide further for pomological exhibits, apples, pears,
- 8 plums, grapes and cannel goods, and said society may
- 9 draw said appropriation from the state treasurer upon its
- 10 voucher that such amount has been paid out each year
- 11 for said purpose.
