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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED  
AND NINETY-THREE.

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AN ACT to amend Section thirty-one of Chapter three of  
the Revised Statutes, relating to Towns.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section thirty-one of chapter three of the  
2 Revised Statutes is hereby amended by striking out the  
3 words "votes cast" in the second and third lines of said  
4 section and inserting in lieu thereof the words 'registered  
5 voters of such city,' so that said section, as amended,  
6 shall read as follows:

'Section 31. No change made by the city council, in the  
8 limits of any city ward, shall be valid unless it is ap-  
9 proved by a majority of the legal registered voters of  
10 such city, at the election of city officers, held next after

11 such action of said council ; and warrants for such ward  
12 meetings shall contain an article for that purpose.'

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
