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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED  
AND NINETY-THREE.

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AN ACT limiting the jurisdiction of Naturalization of  
Foreigners.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. The supreme judicial and superior courts  
2 shall respectively have jurisdiction of applications for  
3 naturalization.

SECT. 2. No other court established by this State shall  
2 entertain any primary or final declaration or application  
3 made by or in behalf of an alien to become a citizen of the  
4 United States, or entertain jurisdiction of the naturaliza-  
5 tion of aliens.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
