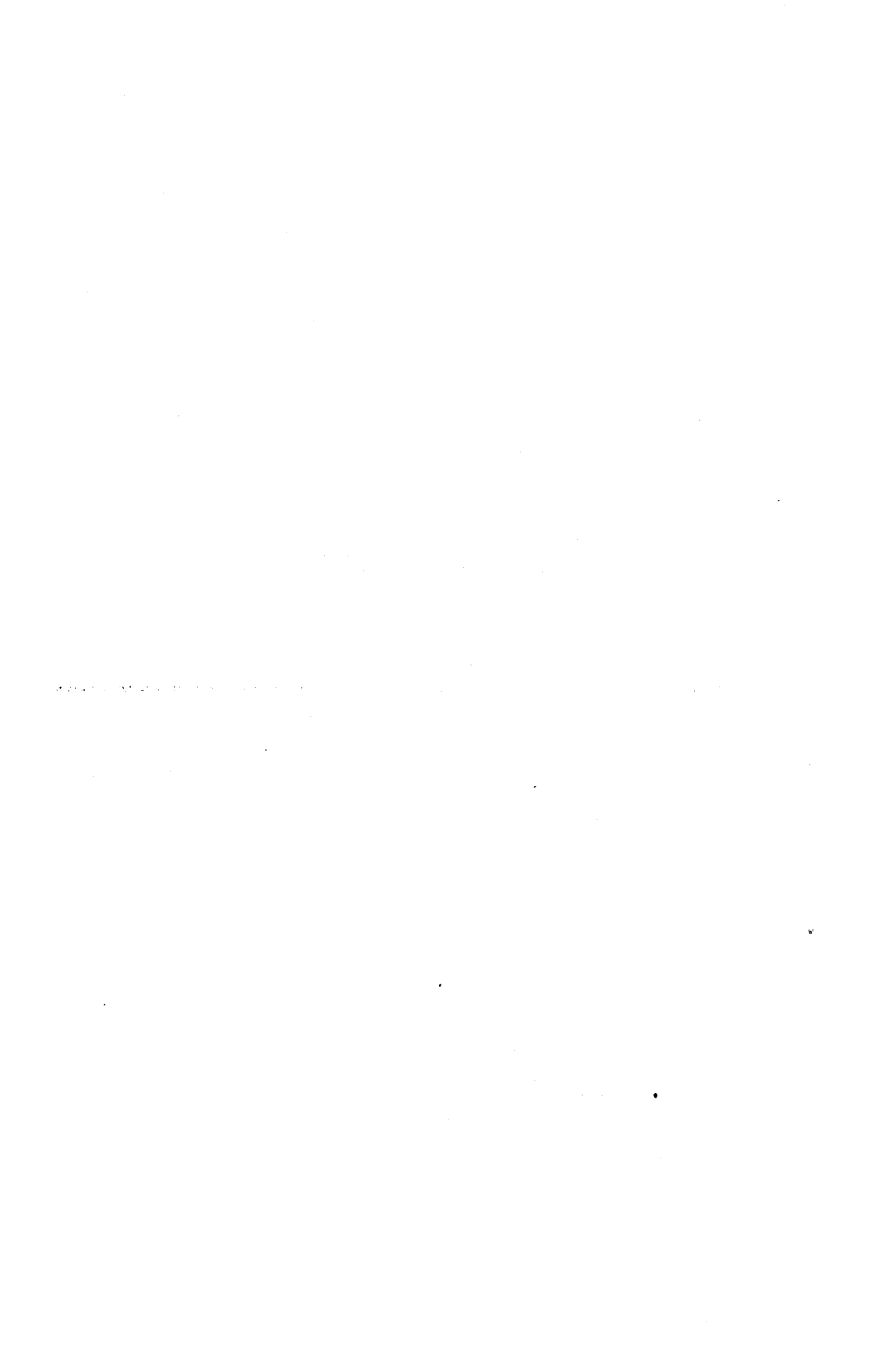
IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT additional to Chapter forty-nine of the Revised
Statutes, relating to Insurance.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Should any insurance company, not organized under
2 the laws of Maine, but doing an insurance busi-
3 ness within this State, make an application to remove
4 any suit or action to which it is a party, heretofore or
5 hereafter commenced in any court of this State, to the
6 United States district or circuit court, or shall enter into
7 any compact or combination with other insurance com-
8 panies for the purpose of governing or controlling the
9 rates charged for fire insurance on any property within

10 this State, the insurance commissioner shall forthwith
11 revoke the license or authority of said company to trans-
12 act business, and no renewal of said license or authority
13 shall be granted for the period of three years from the
14 date of such revocation.
