STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to amend the charter of the Waterville and Fair-
field Railway and Light Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. The Waterville and Fairfield Railway and
2 Light Company is hereby authorized to extend its railroad
3 to, into and through the towns of Benton and Clinton with
4 all the rights, powers and privileges and subject to all the
5 duties, restrictions and liabilities by its charter granted
6 and imposed.

SECT. 2. The said company is further authorized to
2 supply the towns of Clinton and Benton with electricity

3 for light, heat and power and for that purpose may erect,
4 establish and maintain all necessary posts, wires and
5 appliances in the manner provided by general law.

SECT. 3. The towns of Clinton and Benton, and any
2 municipal corporation therein, are authorized to contract
3 with said company for public lighting for a term of years
4 and to renew the same.

SECT. 4. Section thirteen of chapter forty-seven of the
2 Private and Special Laws for eighteen hundred and eighty-
3 seven is hereby repealed.

SECT. 5. This act shall take effect when approved.
