## STATE OF MAINE.

THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED

AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT in reference to the par value of the shares of stock of the Atwood Lock Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The Atwood Lock Company, a corporation

- 2 duly established under the laws of the State of Maine, is
- 3 hereby authorized to change the par value of the shares
- 4 of its stock from one hundred dollars a share to ten dollars
- 5 a share, so that the shares of said corporation instead of
- 6 being one hundred shares of one hundred dollars each
- 7 shall be one thousand shares of ten dollars each. Such
- 8 change shall be effected whenever a majority of the stock-
- 9 holders of said corporation shall, at a meeting legally called
- 10 for that purpose, so vote.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
