STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to authorize Berlin Mills Company to hold stock
and bonds in other corporations.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. The Berlin Mills Company, a corporation
2 organized under the laws of the State of Maine, and hav-
3 ing its principal office at Portland, in said State, is hereby
4 authorized and empowered to acquire, hold and dispose of
5 shares of the capital stock and mortgage bonds of other
6 corporations.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
