STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to amend Chapter 115, Section 8 of the Revised
Statutes relating to compensation of members of the
Legislature.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Section 8 of chapter 115 of the Revised Statutes is
2 hereby amended by striking out in the eleventh line the
3 words “one hundred and fifty,” and inserting instead the
4 words ‘three hundred.’ And by striking out, in the
5 fourteenth line, the word “fifty” and inserting instead the
6 words ‘one hundred.’ And by striking out in the fif-
7 teenth line the word “two” and inserting instead the
8 word ‘four.’ So that said section 8 shall read as follows :

‘Each member of the Senate and House of Representa-
10 tives shall receive three hundred dollars for the regular
11 session of the legislature, and two dollars for every ten
12 miles travel from his place of abode, once in each session.
13 He is entitled to mileage on the first day of the session,
14 and one hundred dollars of his salary on the first day of
15 each month thereafter, during the session, and the bal-
16 lance at the end thereof; but four dollars shall be deducted
17 from the pay of every member for each day that he is
18 absent from his duties, without being excused by the
19 house to which he belongs.’
