IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT additional to Chapter 197 of the Private and Special Laws of 1887, relating to the Limerick Loan and Trust Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

All the provisions of Chapter 197 of the Private and
2 Special Laws of 1887, relating to the incorporation of the
3 Limerick Loan and Trust Company are hereby extended
4 for and during the term of two years from the date of the
5 approval of this act.
