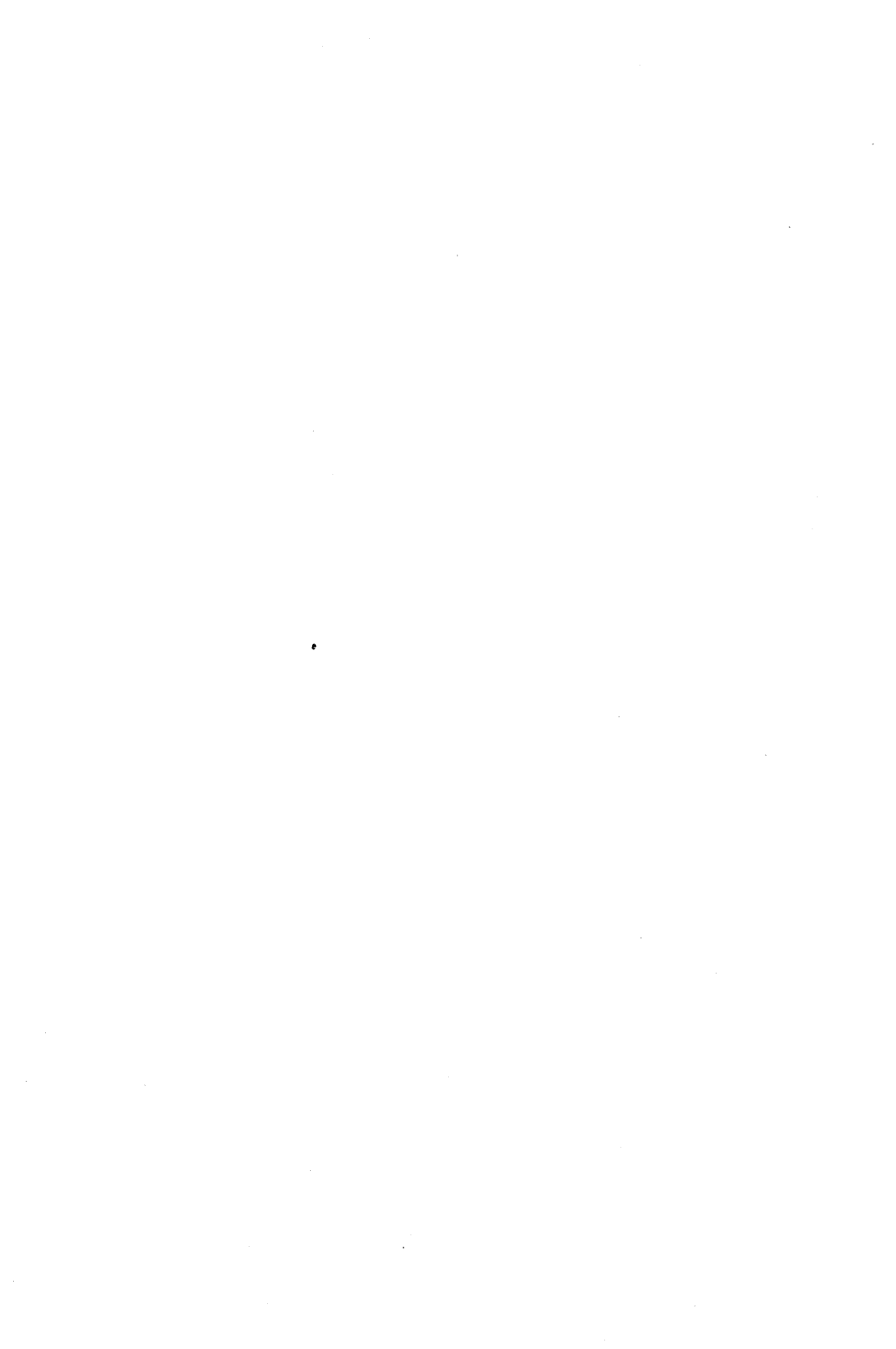

STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of Industrial Exhibits.

Resolved, That the sum of seven hundred and fifty
2 (\$750) dollars be and hereby is annually appropriated to
3 the Maine State Agricultural Society, in addition to the
4 sum heretofore appropriated, for the purpose of encourag-
5 ing the exhibition of the industrial products of Maine as
6 well as increasing the premiums in stock and agricultural
7 classes and also to provide further for pomological exhibits,
8 apples, pears, plums, grapes and canned goods, and said
9 society may draw said appropriation from the State treas-
10 urer upon its voucher that such amount has been paid out
11 each year for said purpose.
