STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to authorize the Lewiston and Auburn Electric Light Company to issue Bonds.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. The Lewiston and Auburn Electric Light
- 2 Company, whose organization is hereby ratified and made
- 3 valid, is hereby authorized to issue its bonds in such
- 4 amount, on such time and at such rate, as it may deter-
- 5 mine, for the purpose of funding its floating debt; paying
- 6 outstanding bonds, and for adding to, extending and
- 7 improving its plant; and to secure said bonds, it may
- 8 mortgage all its property, franchises and easements.
 - SECT. 2. Said company may acquire, hold or dispose
- 2 of stock of any similar corporation in Lewiston or Auburn.
 - SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
