IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED  
AND NINETY-THREE.

---

AN ACT to authorize the Lewiston and Auburn Electric  
Light Company to issue Bonds.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. The Lewiston and Auburn Electric Light  
2 Company, whose organization is hereby ratified and made  
3 valid, is hereby authorized to issue its bonds in such  
4 amount, on such time and at such rate, as it may deter-  
5 mine, for the purpose of funding its floating debt ; paying  
6 outstanding bonds, and for adding to, extending and  
7 improving its plant ; and to secure said bonds, it may  
8 mortgage all its property, franchises and easements.

SECT. 2. Said company may acquire, hold or dispose  
2 of stock of any similar corporation in Lewiston or Auburn.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
