STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to change the time for holding the terms of the
Supreme Judicial Court in Franklin County.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. After the first Tuesday of April in the
2 present year, the supreme judicial court, within and for
3 the county of Franklin, shall be holden at Farmington,
4 in said county, on the first Tuesday of February and on
5 the fourth Tuesday of September, annually, instead of
6 the times as now provided by law. And in addition to
7 the above named terms, the same court shall be held an-
8 nually hereafter, by one of the justices thereof, at said

9 Farmington, on the first Tuesday of June, which last
10 named term shall be held without grand jury, and with
11 only one traverse jury in attendance, unless other-
12 wise specially ordered by any judge of said court.
13 All recognizances and other criminal processes, made re-
14 turnable to, and to have day in said May term, when no
15 criminal business is transacted, shall be continued to, and
16 have day in the next term of said court, held in said
17 county.

SECT. 2. All matters pending in, or returnable to said
2 court, and which would, but for the provisions of this act,
3 have day at the term of said court, to be held on the fourth
4 Tuesday of September of the present year, as provided by
5 law, shall be returnable to, and have day at the term of
6 said court to be held on the first Tuesday of June next.

SECT. 3. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with
2 this act are hereby repealed, and this act shall take effect
3 when approved.
