STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the Maine Insane Hospital.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated for
2 the Maine Insane Hospital the sum of fifteen thousand one
3 hundred and thirty dollars to be used for the following
4 purpose :

For renovating and repairing apartments now unoccu-
6 pied, two thousand four hundred dollars. For repairing
7 the projection at the main entrance to the central building,
8 twelve thousand seven hundred and thirty dollars.



STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The apartments now unoccupied on account of their use during the late diphtheritic epidemic are more than forty years old and need to be thoroughly repaired. The necessary repairs will include floors, plastering, plumbing, and change in the manner of heating. The rooms will accommodate about twenty patients. The stone pillars at the main entrance of the central building have settled several inches breaking the coping and making it necessary to repair it as a measure of safety. An architect who has examined it estimates that the repairs and changes necessary will cost \$12,730.
