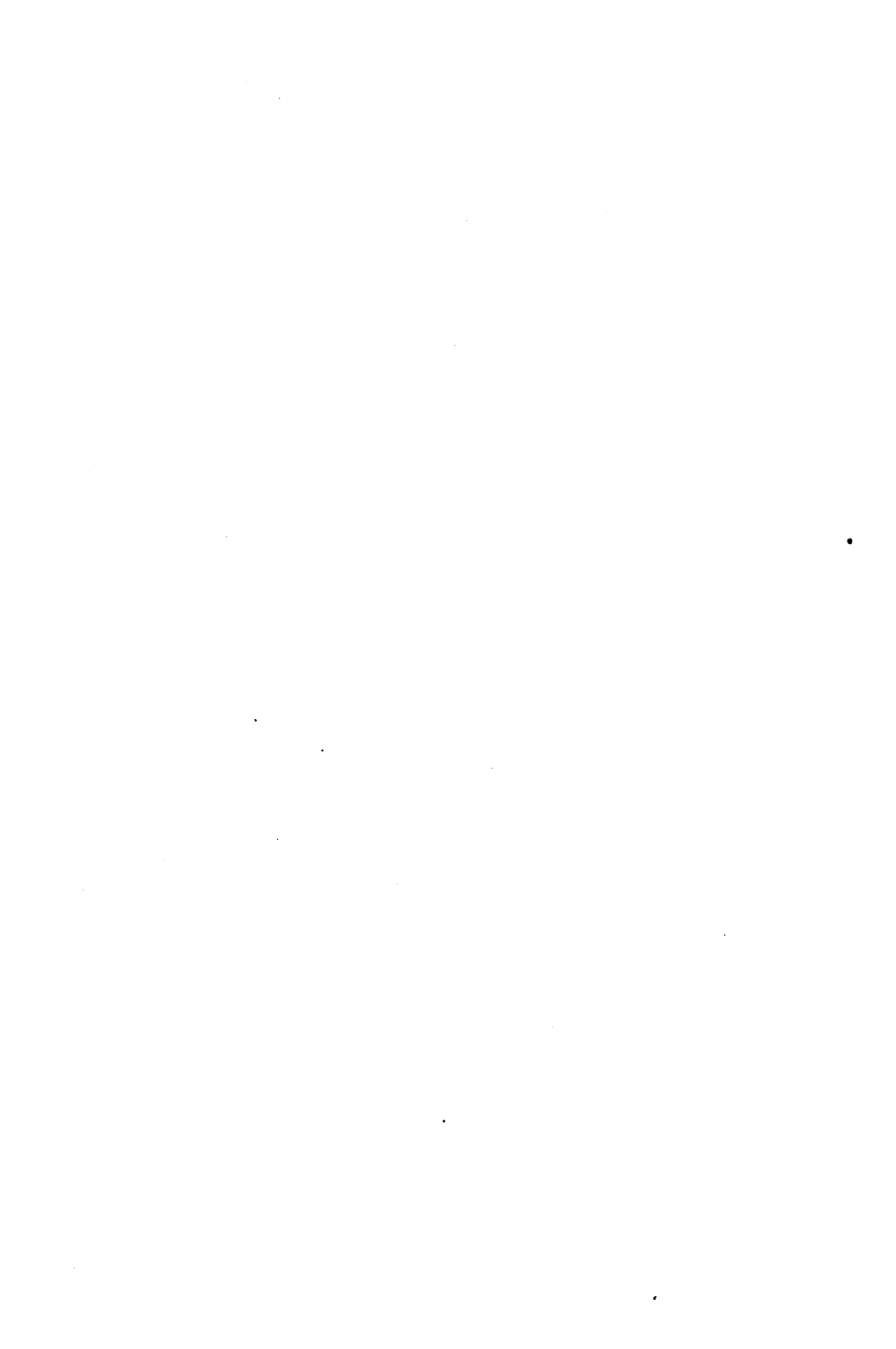
STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to Establish Certain Fees of Registers of Deeds.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

In all cases where books with printed forms are not
2 furnished therefor, registers of deeds shall receive for
3 receiving, filing and recording any instruments under seal,
4 by law entitled to record, in addition to the fees now fixed
5 by law, the sum of fifteen cents for each hundred words,
6 or fraction thereof, in excess of five hundred words.
