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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED  
AND NINETY-THREE.

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AN ACT to amend Chapter 118 of the Public Laws of 1891,  
relating to printing and binding circulars and blanks,  
department Board of Health.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section 14 of chapter 118 of the Public  
2 Laws of 1891 is hereby amended by striking out in the  
3 first line thereof the words "one thousand" and inserting  
4 in place thereof the words 'twenty-five hundred', so that  
5 said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Section 14. The sum of twenty-five hundred dollars  
7 per annum, or as much thereof as may be necessary, is  
8 hereby appropriated for printing and binding the circulars

9 and blanks, for postage, and to defray the expenses of  
10 clerical work in carrying out the provisions of this act.'

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
