## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED  
AND NINETY-THREE.

---

AN ACT to amend “An Act to authorize the sale of the Ministerial and School Lands in the town of New Sharon and to incorporate certain persons by the name of the Trustees of the Ministerial and School Funds in the town of New Sharon.”

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Section two of chapter 108 of the Private and Special  
2 Laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, approved  
3 February 12, 1812, as respects this State, is hereby  
4 amended by adding to said section the following words,  
5 ‘and may hold real and personal estate conveyed to them  
6 in trust for the uses and purposes of a public library for  
7 the use of the town of New Sharon, Maine, and manage  
8 and control the same, effectually for said purposes in

9 addition to all other matters they can now do by law,' so  
10 that said section shall read as follows :

‘Section 2. Be it further enacted, that the trustees  
12 before named be and they are hereby incorporated into a  
13 body politic, by the name of ‘The Trustees of the Minis-  
14 terial and School Funds in the town of New Sharon, and  
15 that they and their successors shall be, and continue a  
16 body politic and corporate forever, and they shall have  
17 and use a common seal, subject to alteration at their  
18 pleasure. And by the name aforesaid they may sue and  
19 be sued, in all actions, real, personal, and mixed, and  
20 prosecute and defend the same to final judgment and  
21 execution, and may hold real and personal estate conveyed  
22 to them in trust for the uses and purposes of a public  
23 library for the use of the town of New Sharon, Maine,  
24 and manage and control the same, effectually for said  
25 purposes, in addition to all other matters they can now do  
26 by law.’
