STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVES fixing the number of copies of certain reports
to be printed at the expense of the State.

Resolved, That the number of copies of the following
2 reports to be printed hereafter at the expense of the
3 State, shall be as follows: namely,

Report of the secretary of agriculture, said reports to
5 contain not over five hundred pages, ten thousand copies
6 for the year 1893 and twelve thousand for the year 1894;
7 of insurance commissioner's report thirteen hundred
8 copies for the year 1893 and fifteen hundred for the year
9 1894; of railroad commissioners' report fifteen hundred
10 copies for each of the years of 1893 and 1894; of labor
11 commissioner's four thousand for the year 1893 and five
12 thousand for the year 1894; of the superintendent of
13 schools four thousand to be issued biennially in Decem-

14 ber 1894; of the adjutant general one thousand to be
15 issued biennially in December, 1894; of treasurer of State
16 two thousand and five hundred annually; of trustees and
17 superintendent of insane hospital twenty-five hundred to
18 be issued biennially in December, 1894; of board of State
19 assessors three thousand to be issued biennially in
20 December, 1894; of trustees and superintendent of reform
21 school two thousand to be issued biennially in December,
22 1894; of attorney general fifteen hundred to be issued
23 biennially in December, 1894; of land agent one thousand
24 to be issued biennially in December, 1894; of warden and
25 inspectors of State prison fifteen hundred to be issued
26 biennially in December, 1894; of commissioners of fish-
27 eries and game three thousand to be issued biennially in
28 December, 1894; of industrial school fifteen hundred to
29 be issued biennially in December, 1894; of the board of
30 health six thousand to be issued biennially in December,
31 1894; of State librarian one thousand to be issued biennially
32 in December, 1894; of trustees of the college of agriculture
33 and mechanic arts one thousand to be issued annually the
34 years 1893 and 1894.

The State librarian is hereby authorized to sell all the
36 above reports to parties not entitled to them by custom
37 of courtesy at cost.

Of the above reports there shall be at least two hundred
39 copies bound in cloth of each delivered to the State libra-
40 rian from the bindery for exchange and library use.

Of the above reports three-fourths of them shall be
42 stitched and bound in cloth, and one-fourth stitched and
43 bound in paper in pamphlet form.

Of the Acts and Resolves of 1893 there shall be printed
45 fourteen hundred copies, to be distributed by the State
46 librarian.

Resolved, That all acts and parts of acts, resolves and
48 parts of resolves, inconsistent herewith, are hereby re-
49 pealed.
