SENATE AMENDMENT "A" TO SENATE DOCUMENT No. 96.

Insert after the word "four" in the eighth line, the words :
And by striking out in the nineteenth line the word "three"
and inserting instead the word 'four.' Also add after the
word "belongs" in the nineteenth line of Senate Document
No. 96 the following: 'The president of the Senate and
speaker of the House of Representatives, shall receive four
hundred dollars for each session, with the same mileage as
other members, and subject to the same deduction in case of
absence.'
