STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to authorize the town of Athens, in Somerset county, to expend a portion of its school money in Somerset Academy.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows.

SECTION 1. The town of Athens at any annual meeting
2 is hereby authorized to direct its superintending school
3 committee to procure the instruction of such scholars in
4 said town, as in their opinion are sufficiently advanced in
5 their studies to attend a grammar or high school, in Som-
6 erset Academy in said town; and said committee shall
7 thereupon contract with the trustees of said academy for
8 such instruction, for which they may expend, from the

9 common school funds of said town, a sum not exceeding
10 that which the scholars so instructed would be entitled to
11 draw upon a *pro rata* division of said funds.

SECT. 2. The trustees shall receive into said academy
2 such scholars as shall be entitled to attend under section
3 1, of this act, and they shall be there instructed in all the
4 regular branches of study taught therein; and said trus-
5 tees shall receive the money apportioned to said academy
6 under said section, in full payment of the regular tuition
7 of said scholars.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
