HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" TO HOUSE DOCUMENT NO. 261.

“RESOLVE in favor of aid in building a highway bridge across the Penobscot River between the village of Winn and the town of Chester” :—

Amend by changing the word “sixteen”, in the sixth line, to ‘eighteen.’

Adopted by House.

HOUSE DOCUMENT “B” ADOPTED BY HOUSE TO HOUSE
DOCUMENT NO. 261.

Entitled, “Resolve in favor of aid in building a highway bridge across the Penobscot river between the village of Winn and the town of Chester,” is hereby amended by striking out in the tenth line all of the resolve after the word “paid,” and inserting therein the following :

‘When the Governor and Council are satisfied that said bridge has been properly constructed and completed ready

for public use, that the sum of five thousand dollars **has** actually been paid in by individual subscription, **seventy-five** hundred dollars raised and paid in by the towns, that a **dam** has been erected and an investment of two hundred and **fifty** thousand dollars will be made for manufacturing purposes.'
