HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" TO HOUSE DOCUMENT No. 120.

Amend by adding: 'Whoever wilfully swears or affirms falsely to any certificate required by this act, is guilty of forgery, and shall pay treble damages to every party injured thereby.'
