STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to protect fish in Garland Pond in Foxcroft and
Sebec in the County of Piscataquis and its outlet.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. No person shall take, catch, kill, fish for,
2 or destroy any fish in the brook, which is the outlet of
3 Garland pond in Sebec, in the County of Piscataquis, for
4 a period of five years from the time when this act takes
5 effect.

SECT. 2. No person shall hereafter take, catch, fish for,
2 or destroy any fish of any kind in said Garland pond in the
3 towns of Foxcroft and Sebec between the first day of
4 October and the first day of the June following.

SECT. 3. Any person who shall violate the provisions
2 this act shall be fined ten dollars and one dollar for each
3 fish so taken, caught, killed or destroyed to be recovered
4 on complaint to the use of the county.
