STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-THREE,

AN ACT to amend Section 12 of Chapter 298 of the Public
Laws of 1889 relating to Hawkers and Peddlers.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section twelve of chapter [two hundred
2 and ninety-eight of the Public Laws of eighteen hundred
3 and eighty-nine is hereby amended by striking out in the
4 fifth line the word "eleven" and inserting instead thereof
5 the word 'ten'; so that said section as amended shall read
6 as follows:

'Section 12. Sheriffs and their deputies, constables and
8 police officers, shall arrest and prosecute every person
9 within their jurisdiction whom they have reason to believe
10 to be guilty of violation of any of the provisions of this

11 act ; and one-half of any fine recovered under section ten
12 of this act shall inure to the prosecutor, the balance to
13 the town or city in which the offense was committed.'

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
