STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT for the better protection of fish in Letter B pond in Upton, County of Oxford.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person or

- 2 persons to take fish in Letter B pond in the town
- 3 of Upton, county of Oxford, otherwise than with a rod,
- 4 single line and artificial flies; provided, however, that the
- 5 fish commissioners of the State may take fish from said
- 6 pond to be used for breeding purposes in the waters of this
- 7 State, at such times as they may decide to be suitable and
- 8 convenient therefor.
 - SECT. 2. Nothing herein shall be held to repeal chap-
- 2 ter two hundred and ninety-one of the Private and Special

- 3 Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-one, except as to
- 4 fishing with single baited hook.
 - SECT. 3. Anyone violating the first section of this act
- 2 shall be punished by a fine not exceeding thirty dollars
- 3 and the costs of prosecution.
 - SECT. 4. This act shall take effect when approved.
