STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE authorizing the destruction of certain State of
Maine bonds.

Whereas, the towns of Haynesville, Long Island, May-
2 field and Trescott have forfeited their claim to any por-
3 tion of the State of Maine bonds issued October 1, 1869,
4 under chapter 225 of the Public Laws of 1868, as amended
5 by chapter 40 of the Public Laws of 1869, and

Whereas, State of Maine bonds to the amount of one
7 thousand two hundred dollars were held in the State
8 treasury as the proportion of said bonds belonging to
9 said towns under the act above referred to, and

Whereas, said bonds are still on hand in the State
11 treasury; therefore be it

Resolved, That the committee first appointed by the
13 governor and council after the passage of this act, to

14 examine the accounts of the State treasurer, are hereby
15 authorized and instructed to destroy by burning said
16 State of Maine bonds, amounting to the par value of one
17 thousand two hundred dollars, together with all coupons
18 attached to same, and furnish certificate of such destruc-
19 tion as provided by section 71, chapter 2 of the Revised
20 Statutes of 1883.
