STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE relating to the Insane of the State.

Resolved, That the governor and council, together with
2 the trustees of the Insane Hospital, are hereby constituted
3 a board of inquiry regarding the needs for further
4 accommodations for the insane of the State.

If in the judgment of said board, or two-thirds of them,
6 an emergency should arise, under which it should appear
7 that more room was imperatively required for insane
8 persons than could be supplied by the present buildings,
9 at the Augusta Hospital, and that some action was neces-
10 sary before the next session of the Legislature; said
11 board is hereby authorized and empowered to proceed
12 with the construction of such additional building or
13 buildings, on the Insane Hospital grounds at Augusta,
14 as they may deem adequate.

They may also purchase such additional land adjoining
16 said hospital grounds at Augusta as they may regard
17 necessary for the purposes indicated.

There is hereby appropriated for the purpose of procur-
19 ing the land and erecting the buildings herein designated
20 the sum of \$55,000 or such portion thereof as may be
21 necessary.
