STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to amend chapter two hundred and thirty-four of
the Public Laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-nine,
entitled “An Act Relating to Fraternal Beneficiary
Organizations.”

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section seven of chapter two hundred and
2 thirty-four of the Public Laws of eighteen hundred and
3 eighty-nine, entitled “An Act Relating to Fraternal Beni-
4 ficiary Organizations,” is hereby amended by striking out
5 the word “April” in the third line thereof and inserting
6 the word ‘March,’ so that said section as amended shall
7 read as follows:

‘Section 7. Every corporation, association or society
9 doing business as herein defined shall annually, on or be-
10 fore the first day of March, report to the insurance com-
11 missioner the names and addresses of its president, secre-
12 tary and treasurer, or other officers answering thereto,
13 and shall make such further statements of its membership
14 and financial transactions for the year ending on the pre-
15 ceding thirty-first day of December, with other informa-
16 tion relating thereto, as said commissioner may deem
17 necessary to a proper exhibit of its business and standing ;
18 and the commissioner may at any other times require any
19 further statement he may deem necessary to be made
20 relating such corporation.’

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
