STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT for the better protection of Fish in Machias Bay.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

The taking of herring, or fishing therefor, by the use of 2 purse and drag seines and all other seines or nets, except 3 the use of seines or nets in weirs, from the first day of 4 June to the first day of November, in the waters of 5 Machias bay and its approaches inside of, or to the north-6 ward of a direct line drawn straight from the highest sum-7 mit of the island called "The Brothers" easterly, to a 8 point one-half mile distant, and due south from Libby 9 island light house, thence from said point easterly to the 10 southern extremity of the southern island called "The 11 Double Head Shots," is hereby prohibited.
