Resolved, That there be paid by the treasurer of state, 2 out of the school fund of the current year, to the town of 3 Warren, the sum of seven hundred and forty-eight dollars 4 and forty-four cents, it being a balance equitably due said 5 town as its proportion of the school funds for the year 6 eighteen hundred and ninety-four.
