## STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE to Repair State Bridge near Seven Islands,  
Upper St. John.

---

*Resolved,* That there is appropriated out of any money  
2 in the treasury of state the sum of five hundred dollars for  
3 the repairs of the state bridge over Depo stream on the  
4 road leading from the Seven Islands on the Upper St. John  
5 river to St. Popham, province of Quebec, Canada.

To be appropriated for the year 1895 and expended by  
7 an agent appointed by the governor, and when said bridge  
8 is completed he shall draw his warrant on the treasury for  
9 the same.



### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Some thirty years ago the State built a bridge over Depo stream flowing into the upper St. John on a road leading to St. Popham, province of Quebec, and as said bridge has rotted down this resolve is to rebuild said bridge.
