IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED  
AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to extend the charter of the Oakland Water  
Company.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

The time within which the Oakland Water Company,  
2 chartered by Private and Special Laws of eighteen hun-  
3 dred and eighty-nine, chapter four hundred sixteen and as  
4 extended by Private and Special Laws of eighteen hun-  
5 dred and ninety-three, chapter four hundred and twenty-  
6 one, is hereby extended within which it may organize and  
7 commence actual business to December 31, 1896. And  
8 said charter and the organization of said company shall be  
9 valid, provided said company shall lay at least two mile of

10 water pipe, for the purpose of supplying the town of Oak-  
11 land, in Kennebec county, Maine, with water for domestic  
12 purposes, in and under and through the streets of Oak-  
13 land village, in said town of Oakland, on or before said  
14 thirty-first day of December, 1897.
