RESOLVE to re-build the State bridge over Fish River on  
the roads leading from Ashland to Fort Kent.

---

*Resolved,* That there is hereby appropriated eight hundred dollars out of any money in the treasury of the state to assist in re-building the bridge over Fish river between Eagle and Long lake, known as the Nedeau bridge, said money to be expended by the county commissioners of Aroostook County and paid by the state when said commissioners have re-built said bridge. Said bridge to be at least four feet higher than the old one.



### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Many years ago the state built a bridge over Fish river called the Nedeau bridge. It has become rotten, and this appropriation is to assist the county in re-building said bridge.
