RESOLVE authorizing the purchase of a certain number of copies of Freeman's "Supplement to the Revised Statutes," for the use of the State.

---

*Resolved,* That the sum of seven thousand and five hundred dollars is hereby appropriated for the purchase of fifteen hundred copies of Freeman's Supplement to the Revised Statutes, to be distributed by the state librarian, under the direction of the governor and council, each copy to be of uniform excellence and equal in quality of paper, binding and typography to those copies of the Revised Statutes of 1883, furnished to the state by Loring, Short and Harmon.
