STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to provide for uniform blanks and rules of practice
and procedure in the Courts of Probate and Insolvency.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. A commission, composed of three judges
2 and two registers of the probate and insolvency courts,
3 to be appointed by the governor immediately upon the
4 passage of this act, shall prepare before the third Tues-
5 day of July eighteen hundred and ninety-five, rules of
6 practice and procedure in said courts, and also blanks for
7 use in said courts, which rules and blanks shall be sub-
8 mitted to the supreme judicial court for approval; and
9 when approved by the last named court or a majority of

10 the justices thereof said rules of practice and procedure
11 shall take effect, and be in force in all courts of probate
12 and insolvency; and no other blanks shall be used in the
13 courts of probate and insolvency, after the expiration of
14 two years from the time of the approval thereof as herein
15 provided. And such a commission, appointed at any
16 time by the governor, at the request in writing of a
17 majority of the judges of the probate and insolvency
18 courts, may make new rules and blanks or amendments to
19 existing rules and blanks, which new rules and blanks or
20 amended rules and blanks shall, when approved by the
21 supreme judicial court or a majority of the justices
22 thereof, take effect and be in force in all courts of probate
23 and insolvency.

SECT. 2. Said commission or commissions, so appointed,
2 shall make a report to the governor of such expenses as
3 may have been incurred in carrying out the provisions of
4 this act, and upon the approval of the same by the gover-
5 nor and council, they shall be allowed and paid in the same
6 manner as other claims against the state.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
