## STATE OF MAINE.

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-FIVE

AN ACT additional to chapter two of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-two, relating to the Lewiston Bleachery and Dye Works.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. The Lewiston Bleachery and Dye Works 2 is authorized and empowered to locate, construct and 3 maintain a railroad track and trolley wire over the same, 4 extending from its works in the city of Lewiston, across 5 Lisbon street, in a general westerly direction, to a connec-6 tion with the tracks of the Maine Central Railroad Com-7 pany, and to operate the same by means of electricity, for 8 the sole purpose of transporting freight between its works

9 and said Maine Central Railroad, provided that it shall10 first obtain the consent of the municipal officers of the city11 of Lewiston, and of the owners of the land through which12 said track shall be located.

SECT. 2. The manner and conditions of crossing said 2 Lisbon street shall be determined by the railroad commis-3 sioners in accordance with the provisions of section twenty-4 seven of chapter eighteen of the Revised Statutes, as 5 amended.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
