## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT for the protection of Smelts in Damariscotta river and bay.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. All persons are hereby prohibited from fish2 ing for or catching smelts in Damariscotta river and bay
3 and their tributaries above a line drawn from Farhnam's
4 Head in the town of Boothbay to a point opposite on the
5 shore in the town of Bristol, by the use of purse or drag
6 seines; and all persons are hereby prohibited from fishing
7 for or catching smelts in said river, bay or tributaries with
8 weirs, north of the ledge known as "The Ledges."

- SECT. 2. Any person violating the provisions of this 2 act shall be punished by a fine of one hundred (100) dol-3 lars for each offense; such fine to be recovered by com-4 plaint or indictment, one-half to the use of the complainant 5 and one-half to the county where the proceedings are com-6 menced. Full jurisdiction to impose said fine is hereby 7 conferred upon trial justices.
- SECT. 3. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with 2 this act are hereby repealed.
  - SECT. 4. This act shall take effect when approved.
