STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to amend section 47 of chapter 6 of the Revised
Statutes in regard to Street Railroads.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. Section 47 of chapter 6 of the Revised
2 Statutes is hereby amended by striking out the word
3 "horse" in the first line of said section, and inserting in
4 the place thereof the word 'street,' so that said section as
5 amended shall read as follows :

'Section 47. Street railroad corporations and associa-
7 tions are subject to the six preceding sections and to
8 section four, except that the tax shall be ascertained as

9 follows : when the gross average receipts per mile do not
10 exceed one thousand dollars, the tax shall be equal to one-
11 tenth of one per cent on the gross transportation receipts ;
12 and for each thousand dollars additional average gross
13 receipt per mile, or fractional part thereof, the rate shall
14 be increased one-tenth of one per cent.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
