STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of Castine State Normal School.

Resolved, That there be appropriated for the year eigh-2 teen hundred and ninety-five the sum of two thousand dol-3 lars for repairs on the normal school building in Castine. 4 The same to be expended under the direction of the trus-5 tees of the normal schools. •

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The roof of the normal school building at Castine is very defective and leaks badly. The windows of this building are also very defective and new ones are needed throughout. The ceiling of several of the recitation rooms needs renewing. This building also needs repainting, as this has been done but once in twenty-two years. The brick work also needs some repairs. The board of trustees after careful examination are convinced that the amount specified in the resolve is absolutely needed.
