STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of State Pension, expending money
under direction of Governor and Council.

Resolved, That the state pension agent is hereby author-
2 ized to expend such sum under the direction of the governor
3 and council, not exceeding three hundred dollars yearly, as
4 may be necessary, to properly examine the claims presented
5 to his office, the same to be paid out of the appropriation
6 for soldiers' pensions, for years eighteen hundred ninety-
7 five and eighteen hundred ninety-six.
