STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to exempt from taxation the property of all Agricultural, Horticultural and Mechanical Associations, so long as held and used solely for exhibition purposes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. All property, real and personal, owned and controlled by legally incorporated agricultural, horticultural and mechanical societies, and used solely for annual exhibitions of the stock and products of the state, shall hereafter be exempt from taxation for state, county and municipal purposes, so long as so held and used.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
