AN ACT to extend the time for the completion of the Brunswick Electric Railroad Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

The time for the completion of the Brunswick Electric
2 Railroad Company, as specified in section one, chapter six
3 hundred and forty-three of the Private and Special Laws
4 for the year one thousand eight hundred and ninety-three
5 is hereby extended two years from the date therein named.
