STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE providing for the purchase and distribution of
Savage's Index-Digest of the Maine Reports.

Resolved, That the State Librarian, under the supervision of the Governor and Council, be, and he is hereby authorized to contract for the purchase of eight hundred copies of Savage's Index-Digest of the Maine Reports, at a sum not exceeding six dollars per copy, said digest to be equal in paper, printing and binding to Plaisted and Appleton's Digest; and the State Librarian is hereby required to distribute said digest the same as Maine Reports are by law distributed, and among the several towns and plantations, public libraries within the state, and such other public institutions as may desire the same, and he may use the same for exchanges.
