STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to amend section one of chapter fifty-two of the Public Laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-seven entitled "An Act creating a Lien on Colts."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section one of chapter fifty-two of the Public Laws of 2 eighteen hundred and eighty-seven, creating a lien on 3 colts is hereby amended, as follows: by striking out the 4 word "five" in the fourth line of said section, and insert-5 ing the word 'six' in the same line so that said section as 6 amended shall read as follows:

'Section 1. A lien is hereby created on all colts here-8 after foaled in this state, to secure the payment of the 9 service fee, for the use of the stallion begetting the same. 10 Such lien is to continue in force until the foal is six 11 months old, and may be enforced during that time by 12 attachment of such foal.'
