# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-FIVE

AN ACT to amend section thirty-two of chapter ninety-one the Revised Statutes, relating to Liens.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 32 of chapter 91 of the Revised Statutes is 2 hereby amended by striking out the word "thirty" and 3 inserting the word 'forty' so that said section as amended 4 shall read as follows:

'Section 32. The lien mentioned in the preceding sec-6 tion shall be dissolved unless the claimant within forty 7 days after he ceases to labor or furnish materials as afore-8 said, files in the office of the clerk of the town in which 9 such building is situated, a true statement of the amount 10 due him, with all just credits given, together with a 11 description of the property intended to be covered by the 12 lien, sufficiently accurate to identify it, and the names of 13 the owners, if known; which shall be subscribed and 14 sworn to by the person claiming the lien, or by some one 15 in his behalf, and recorded in a book kept for that pur-16 pose, by said clerk, who is entitled to the same fees there-17 for as for recording mortgages.'
